The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned regular session. Present Kretzinger, Steele and Horsford. Board continued considering bills for approval or disapproval.

The Commissioners met at the Fred Hill and Adam Schick corners for the purpose of viewing the corners to be rounded. They then returned to the Court House and filed the following Report:

Report of County Commissioners on Road View  
Pursuant to Resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on July 23, 1923, the Board of County Commissioners G. E. Kretzinger, Robert A. Steele and C. B. Horsford, together with the Engineer, did on this, the 11th day of August, proceed to the southwest corner of Section 9, Township 14 S., Range 20 E., and meet there Fred Hill, Representative of the owner of the land hereinafter described, for the purpose of viewing the proposed rounding of the corner at that location, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point one hundred and twenty five (125) feet N. and thirty (30) feet E. of the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 9, T. 14 S., R. 20 E.; thence South one hundred (100) feet along the east line of the public Right of Way; thence East (100) one hundred feet along the north line of the public road; thence in a northwesterly direction along the
