Report of County Commissioners on Road View.

Pursuant to Resolution passed by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on July 23, 1923, The Board of County Commissioners, G. E. Kretzinger, Robert A. Steck and C. B. Hosford, together with the Engineer, did on this, the 11th day of August, 1923, proceed to the northeast corner of Section 16, Township 14 S., Range 20 E., and meet there Adam Shick, the owner of the land hereinafter described, for the purpose of viewing the proposed rounding of the corner at that location, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point one hundred and thirty-one and eighty-eight one-hundredths (131.88) feet West and twenty-five (25) feet South of the Northeast corner of Section 16, Township 14 S., Range 20 E.; thence East along South line of public Right of Way one hundred (100) feet; thence South along West line of public Right of Way one hundred (100) feet; thence in a North-westerly direction along the arc of a circle with one hundred (100) foot radius, a distance of one hundred and fifty-seven (157) feet to the point of beginning, containing $\frac{1}{20}$ of an acre more or less.

The Board finds this to be a dangerous corner and the rounding of the said corner to be necessary in the interest of public safety, and that the rounding of said corner will require $\frac{1}{20}$ of an acre of land and the building of a new fence for Adam Shick, the owner of said land, the fence to be approximately ten rods of woven wire, since the rest of this field is hog tight.
