

Wednesday August 15, 1923.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session; present Kretzinger, Steele and Hosford. The following Resolution was passed by the Board:

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners
ere in regular session this 15th day of August, 1923,
that in the case of the State of Kansas vs. Ed. Wright
the defendant having served his sentence, and having
paid the costs in said case, the fine imposed shall be re-
mitted to said defendant, and the Sheriff of Douglas County
Kansas, is hereby authorized to release said defendant.

Mr. Kretzinger brought in the complaint concerning
the hedge along the D. D. Tuttle place about 120 rods west
of the southeast corner of Section 15, T. 14 S. and R. 20 E.,
and the County Clerk was instructed to send the official
Hedge Notice to D. D. Tuttle, which Notice follows:

Ureland, Kansas

Dear Sir: The Board of County Commissioners of
Douglas County, Kansas, instruct me to inform you, and you
are hereby notified officially to cut the hedge along the Township
road where the said Township road crosses the railroad
at the following described location, to wit:

About one hundred and twenty rods (120) rods west of
the southeast corner of Section 15, Township 14 S., Range 20 E.
This notice is in accordance with Chapter 221 of the
1921 Session of the Laws of Kansas, a copy of which we here-
