

Tuesday September 4 - 1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session. Present Kutsinger, Steele ^{and Hafford}. Current bills were audited for approval or disapproval. Reports for the month of August from Mrs. Kennedy, Commissioner of Poor, E. C. Liger, Left County Farm and E. R. Keith Health Officer were approved.

Thursday September 6 - 1923.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present Kutsinger, Steele & Hafford. The Board continued considering bills for approval and disapproval.

The Board approved the appointment of James Warner for deputy sheriff.

Charles Becks of Baldwin placed a written request before the Board to have Lot 53 Chapel Street marked Exempt on tax rolls for the reason the same was exempt prior to 1922 and had been erroneously placed on the tax roll. After the Board satisfied themselves that the facts were true. A motion by Hafford, seconded by Steele passed unanimously that the county Clerk instruct the county Treasurer as follows:

Cancel the tax and other charges for the year 1922, on Lot 53, Chapel Baldwin Kansas for the reason said property belongs to the Colored Methodist of Baldwin and is used for church purposes and that said property was erroneously placed on the tax roll in 1922. Having been formally exempt and that the county Clerk mark this property exempt on the tax roll.
