Saturday Oct 6 - 1923

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present Kretzinger, Steele & Hosford. Some bills that were late in coming in were considered. The bill of Fred Stoll was taken up for reconsideration. After a long discussion of the matter of damages and expense relative to rounding the corner on the Fred Will farm, with Mr. Hill, the Board order the County Clerk to cancel the old warrant for \$64.80 and make out a new warrant for \$100.00.
