

Monday, November, 5th 1943-

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session. Present, Kretzinger, Steele and Hoof. Bills were audited and allowed.

The Board instructed the Co. Clerk to issue an order to the Co. Treasurer, cancelling the tax of Elliot Porter, J. M. Boyd, & Dollar Tire Co on personal property, same being an erroneous assessment as shown in Order #11.

The Board authorized the application by the County Treasurer for three hundred fifty & $\frac{67}{100}$ dollars claim against the State Treasurer for state taxes against personal property on which the Sheriff has returned tax warrants "not found" & "no property".

The following Resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board.

Whereas the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, has adopted a resolution which is attached hereto providing for the improvement of south Missouri street and the road connecting therewith from the south end of the present pavement on Missouri street at a point near its intersection with Eleventh street, thence south and southwesterly along the west line of said city, thence following road numbered 35 to the road along the west side of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 17, range 19, thence south along said quarter section line and following said road numbered 35 and road numbered 74 to a point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36, all of said road outside of the City of Lawrence being of a length of less than $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile, by paving such street and road at a width of twenty-five feet, including gutters and curbs, said paving to be concrete according to plans and specifications to be approved by the City Engineer, and

Whereas, said Resolution, further provides that the same should be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, for its adoption and further consideration and action as provided by Chapter 94 of the Laws of Kansas of 1941, and

Whereas, upon due consideration of said Resolution by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, it is found that said resolution is in due form, and that the proposed improvement is a public necessity and utility. Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and it is hereby declared by the said Board that the proposed improvement, to-wit: The paving of south Missouri street and the road connecting therewith from a point
