

resolution on said proposed improvement.

The following resolution was passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, concerning the same road:

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, which is a city of the second class having less than 6,500 inhabitants, deem it expedient and advisable and at public necessity to grade, curb, gutter, pave or otherwise improve South Missouri street and the country road, connecting therewith from the south end of the present pavement on

Missouri street in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, at a point near the intersection of Eleventh street with said Missouri street, thence south and southwesterly along the west line of said city, thence following road numbered 35 to the road along the west side of the southeast quarter of section 36, Township 17, Range 19, Douglas County, Kansas. Thence south along said quarter section line following said road numbered 35 and also road numbered 74 to a point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36, all of said road outside of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, being less than six eighths of a mile in length, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided; Therefore be it resolved by the Board of

Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas; That said road from the end of the present pavement on South Missouri street, Lawrence, Kansas, thence south and southwesterly along the west city limits of said city, thence following roads numbered 35 and 74 to the west line of said southeast quarter of section 36, township 17, range 19, Douglas County, Kansas, thence south along the road on said quarter section line to a point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36, be graded, curbed, guttered, paved or otherwise improved from the end of said pavement on Missouri street to said point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36.

That said street or road be paved or otherwise improved for a width of twenty-five feet, including gutters, and that said paving be of concrete according to plans and specifications to be approved by the City engineer. That in order to provide for the payment of the cost of said improvements, in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided, as may be assessed against the benefit district to be created within said city of Lawrence, the number of assessments to be levied upon the lots, tracts or parcels of land situated therein shall be ten, and the said benefit district shall be all that part of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, embraced within the following boundaries, to wit:
