And that subsequent to said April 30, 1923 the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did also pass a resolution finding that the road mentioned in said resolution was a public utility, and setting date the 4th day of December 1923, as the date when complaints and written objections may be made by the parties interested, against building of said road. That thereafter the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas:

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has adopted the resolution heretofore adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, on April 30, 1923, and has declared, the improvement of South Missouri street and the road connecting therewith from the south end of the present pavement on Missouri street at a point near its intersection with Eleventh street thence south and southwesterly along the west line of said city, thence following road numbered 35 to the road along the west side of the southeast quarter of section 36, Township 17, Range 19, thence south along said quarter line and following said road numbered 35 and road numbered 74 to a point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36, all of said road outside of the City of Lawrence, being of a length of less than 7/8 of a mile, said street to be paved or otherwise improved at a width of twenty five feet including curbs and gutters, said paving to be constructed of concrete according to plans and specifications to be approved by the City Engineer, is a public necessity and utility, and Whereas, said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, has sep. Dec. 4th 1923, at ten o'clock A.M. at its office in the Court House in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, as the time and place for hearing complaints, protests and written objections to said proposed improvement and for taking final action on said resolution, and Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, is required to give notice of such hearing, therefore be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, that notice be given to all persons affected thereby, that complaints, protests and written objections against
