Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that we are strongly in favor of the retention of the Midland Trail through Douglas County, Kansas, as a part of the Federal Aid System of Public Highways, which are eligible to receive federal aid in the construction of hard surfaced roads, and we urgently request that Kansas State Highway Commission to use its best efforts with the Federal Authorities to cause the Midland Trail between Kansas City, Missouri, and Lawrence, Kansas, to be included in the approved system of Federal Aid Roads.

Road Petition to Vacate.

Signed by Jerry Lyons and eleven others to vacate the road described as follows

Beginning at the north-west corner of the north-west quarter of Section 3, Township 13, Range 19, thence east on the north-line of Section 3, as the road is now laid out to the north-east corner of said section 3-13-19, being part of Road number 371 in Wakarusa Township.
