

January 1924 -

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January 7th

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session with G. E. Kretzinger, Robt. A. Steele & C. B. Hosford present.

The Board re-organized by electing C. B. Hosford chairman of the Board for the ensuing year (1924). Robt. A. Steele was elected chairman pro-tem. Claims against the county were examined and allowed.

Henry Gillum was unanimously elected custodian of the Court house for the ensuing year with a salary of \$100 per month. Dr Keith was elected Health officer & G. C. Rizer Superintendent of the County Farm for the ensuing year.

The Board refunded \$25.65 to A. B. Cummings in Wakarusa township on account of erroneous rate in Wakarusa Twp - gen fund.

The Board refunded the tax on \$500 to Guy H. Dixon on the part of lot 7 Pritchney St. on account of erroneous assessment on the improvements on said lot & ordered the clerk to reduce said improvement \$500.

The Board accepted the resignation of J. E. Hardtger as Trustee of Marion township and appointed J. H. Baldwin trustee of Marion township for the ensuing year.

A petition signed by James Miller & 43 others was filed asking for aid on township road as follows -

Beginning at a point where the north line of Kanwaka township intersects the west line of Wakarusa township; thence south on the township lines to where said road intersects with the Fort to Fort Highway.

January 9th 1924 -

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, with C. B. Hosford, Robt. A. Steele & G. E. Kretzinger present.

Bills were examined and allowed.

A motion made by Mr Steele & seconded by Mr Kretzinger was unanimously carried to make the salary of Co. Engineer E. E. Trueblood \$2400 for the ensuing year.

The Board appointed C. H. Daugherty, H. G. Hawtaste & A. M. Walters Viewers of the Henry Bahnmair road and set the date to view same February 6th at 10 A. M. at location of described road.
