

Monday - February 4 - 1924

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session. Present Hosford, Steele & Kuttlinger. Bills were passed on by the Board.

The appointment of Adolph Ewing, as deputy sheriff was approved by the Board.

The resignation of W. H. Barton as Clerk of Clinton Township was accepted and J. M. Cummings was appointed to fill out the unexpired term.

The Board of the Home State Bank of Eudora was approved by the Board.

The monthly reports of S. C. Sizer, Supt. of County Home, M. Emma J. Kennedy, Com. of Poor and Dr. E. R. Keith, Health Officer, were approved.

By order from the State Tax Commission the Personal Property Tax on the property of the Almenia Fraternity was cancelled. See order to County Treasurer, number 25.

The Board order the tax cancelled on a certain mortgage, described as personal property belonging to Fred Ott, of Eudora Twp School district #71 - See order #26 - to County Treasurer.

Tuesday, February 6 - 1924

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present chairman Hosford, and Commissioner Kuttlinger. On account of the deep snowdrifts commissioner Steele was unable to reach the meeting.

Bills were passed on by the Board. Considerable time was consumed in studying different styles of road graders and maintainers.

The views of the Harry Bahnmair road brought in their report, in which they recommended that the vacation and relocation be made as petitioned for. The Board approved the report and instructed the County Clerk to inform the township trustee that he should proceed to open the road.
