Saturday Feb 9-1924

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Chairman C. B. Hosford, & J. E. Kretzinger. The engineer, E. E. Trueblood was instructed to ask the Federal Highway commission for a route survey between Lawrence & Baldwin. The Board ordered a refund to Ethel Swenson on \$1000⁰⁰ valuation, erroneous assessment. Also to Fred Ott of Escoda twp. on \$8500⁰⁰ erroneous assessment.

In the matter of Henry Balmmaier road - G. A. Anderson & Henry Balmmaier signed papers relieving the county from paying damages on account of the location of the road along their farms. Mr. Balmmaier did not ask any damages and Mr. Anderson was allowed \$10⁰⁰ for moving his fence.

Wednesday Feb. 13-1924.

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Hosford, Steele and Kretzinger.

W. N. Barton and 19 others presented a petition asking for the relocation of the County Road at the following described location. - to wit -

Beginning at a point in the N.E.⁴ of sec. 23 T.13S. R.18E. which point is just east of the concrete culvert on the Clinton road at the L. E. Johnson place, thence in a north easterly direction, to a point in the Clinton road, just west of the concrete culvert at the intersection of the Bloomington road; the last mentioned point being on the N. line of the N.W.⁴ Sec 24 T.13S. R.18E. Thereby eliminating four bad curves, and vacate the present county road between the two points.
