French Bridge

The Board of County Commissioners met in Special session at 10 A.M. Present: Hooford, Steele & Kistinger. At eleven o'clock A.M. the chairman, (C. B. Hooford) called for the opening of the bids for the construction of the French bridge. a 40ft pony steel span according to estimate of the county engineer, E. C. Trustblood. The bids were opened by the county clerk, examined by the county attorney A. B. Mitchell and read by the county engineer, and were as follows. Burns Bros. \$1240.¹⁰ P. L. Ehrlich & Co. Smithville, Mo. \$1484.⁵⁰ Midland Bridge Co. K.C. Mo. \$1595.³⁰ Cornell & Meder Topeka Kansas \$1339.¹⁵. The Board took the bids under consideration, promising to report at one o'clock P.M.
