Minutes of meeting of joint board composed of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co., Kansas; and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, under the provisions of Chapter 92 of the session laws of the State of Kansas of 1921.

And now on this 8th day of April, 1924, at a meeting of the joint board, composed of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, under the provisions of Chapter 92 of the session laws of the State of Kansas, for 1921, being sections 12-647 to 12-655 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas of 1923, comes on for consideration and action the survey, plans, specifications and estimates of cost of the improvement of South Missouri street and the road connected therewith from the south end of the present driveway on Missouri street at a point near its intersection with Eleventh Street, thence south and southwesterly along the west line of said city, thence following road numbered 35 to the road along the west side of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 12, range 19, Douglas County, Kas., thence south along said quarter section line and following said road numbered 35 and road numbered 74 to a point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36, all of said road outside of the City of Lawrence being of a length of less than $\frac{7}{8}$ of a mile, as provided in the final resolution adopted the 8th day of December, 1923, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, and by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and as ordered by said joint board above referred to on Dec. 8th 1923, and said joint Board, after examination of said survey, plans, specifications and
