

Estimate of Cost, as submitted by Low S. Henderson, City Engineer of Lawrence, Kansas, and after due consideration thereof, finds:

First: That said Surveys, Plans, Specifications & Estimates of Cost provide for the most expedient and advisable route and the best method of construction for the proposed improvement of the street and road above described, as ordered by said final resolution Dec. 8th 1923

Second: That said Surveys, Plans, Specifications and Estimates of Cost have been approved by the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas.

Third: That said Surveys, Plans, Specifications and Estimates of Cost should be approved by this Joint Board, and a date fixed for receiving bids for the proposed improvement.

It is therefore ordered by this Joint Board, composed of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, a majority of each of said Boards concurring therein, that the Surveys, Plans, Specifications and Estimates of Cost of the proposed improvement of the street and road above described as provided for in said final resolution passed Dec. 8th 1923, be and the same are hereby approved, and that notice be given according to law in the official County paper and in the official city paper that bids for constructing the proposed improvement will be received by said Joint Board up to and including April 26th 1924, at 10 o'clock A.M. at the Office of the County Commissioners.

Where said bids will be opened at a meeting of said Joint Board and be acted upon, all as provided by statute in such cases made and provided.

And be it further ordered, that a copy of the minutes of the Joint Board above be recorded at length upon the records of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, and of the City Clerk of Lawrence, Kansas.
