

just west of the concrete culvert at the intersection of the Bloomington road, the last mentioned point being in the north line of N. 20th, sec. 24, township 13 S, range 18 E, thereby eliminating four bad curves, and vacating the present county road and terminating between the above described points.

Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners appointed C. B. Haasford, Robt Steele and G. E. Koetsinger to view the road with the County engineer, April 26th 1924 at 4 p.m. and give all parties a hearing.

For the matter of the Road Petition filed by Henry Washington and others for the re-location and vacation of a certain road described as follows.

Beginning at a point 20 feet east of the SW cor. of sec. 18, township 13 S, Range 19 E., thence north parallel to the west line of said sec. 18, about 99 rods to a point, 20 feet East and 20 feet South of the South-west cor. of Lewis Simpfaris tract, thence east parallel to South line of Lewis Simpfaris tract to a point of intersection with the present old road, and vacate the present road from the point where it leaves the Clinton county road to point and intersecting at of intersection with the proposed new location.

The Board appointed Joe Hoover, She Holcomb, and B. S. Sanders to view the road with the County Engineer, Wednesday May 7th 1924 at 2 p.m.

For the matter of the Road Petition filed by Wilson Martin and others for the location of a certain road described as follows.

Beginning at the north-east cor. of the north-west quarter of sec. 32, township 12, range 19, thence South on the center line of sec. 32 to the South-east cor. of the south-west quarter of sec. 32, township 12, range 19.

The Board appointed J. J. Tobler, Walter Pontius and Chris Schaahe to view the road with the County engineer, Wednesday May 7th 1924 at 10 a.m.
