Minutes of the meeting of the Joint Board composed of the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, under the provisions of Chapter 93 of the Session Laws of Kansas for 1921, being sections 12-647 to 12-655 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923, held April 26th 1924.

Now on this 26th day of April 1924, at a meeting of the Joint Board composed of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, under the provisions of Chapter 93 of the Session Laws of Kansas for 1921, the same being sections 12-647 to 12-655 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923, come on for consideration and action the bids made by various proposed contractors for doing the proposed improvement of South Missouri Street and the road connecting them with from the south end of the present pavement on Missouri Street at a point near its intersection with Eleventh Street, thence south and southwesterly along the west line of said city, thence following road numbered 38 to a road along the west side of the southeast quarter of section 36, Township 12, Range 19, Douglas County, Kansas, thence south along said quarter section line and following said road 38 and road 74 to a point 120 rods south of the center of said section 36, all of said road outside of the city of Lawrence, being of a length of less than five-eighths of a mile, in accordance with a resolution of this joint board dated April 8th 1924, and in accordance with notices published in the official county paper and the official city paper setting April, 26th 1924, at ten o'clock A.M., as the date and time on which said bids would be opened and considered.

Proof of publication of the notices as published in the Official County Paper and proof of publication of notices as published in the Official City Paper, are submitted and upon consideration of said notices and proof thereof, and said Joint Board finds that said notices are in accordance with statutes and have been published in the time and manner provided by statute, and does hereby approve and confirm same.

Thereupon, all bids received by the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, and the City Clerk of Lawrence, Kansas, in accordance with said published notices, are opened and considered by said Joint Board, and after due consideration thereof, said Joint Board finds that Rowan & Rickard, whose bid for the construction for said improvement, in accordance with the surveys, plans & specifications is \$19,209.87, unless local stone
