

for the concrete to be used, which will pass inspection of the City Engineer, in which case there should be a deduction of eighteen cents for each square yard of concrete in which local stone is used, is the lowest and best bidder, and should be awarded the contract for the making of the proposed improvements of the hereinbefore mentioned and described.

It is therefore ordered by the Joint Board, composed of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, a majority of each of said Boards concurring therein, that the contract for the making and doing the proposed improvement of the hereinabove described road and street, in accordance with the plans, specifications and surveys, be awarded to said Rowan and Rickard at the contract price of \$19,207.59, as set out in their proposal, the same being the lowest and best bid for the making and doing of said improvement.

And Be It Further Ordered, that said contract be executed on behalf of said Joint Board by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, and by the Mayor of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, upon said contractors, Rowan and Rickard, giving bond at the contract price, and upon said bond being approved, all as provided in Section 5 of Chapter 93 of the Session Laws of Kansas of 1921.

And Be It Further Ordered, that upon said contract being fully executed and bond given as above provided, that said proposed improvement under said contract shall be conducted under the supervision of the City Engineer of the City of Lawrence, Kansas.

And Be It Further Ordered, that a copy of the minutes of the Joint Board above be recorded at length upon the records of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, and of the City Clerk of Lawrence, Kansas.

The Board Adjourned.
