The Board made the following report on the vacation of certain road as petitioned for by M. A. Childs and others. Jack Childs & Wm. H. Johanning were present and stated there had not been a wagon over that road for ten years. No one appeared to oppose the petition. On motion by Steele seconded by Kretzinger the Board unanimously voted to vacate the road as petitioned for.

Saturday May - 10-1924.

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Hosford, Kretzinger, & Steele. The Board continued to allow bills as per the warrant record. The engineer E. E. Trumbull reported the bridge acceptance for Captains Creek amount \$7,186.68. Burns Bros filed their affidavit showing all labor and material paid for all damages settled. Their warrant for balance was turned over to them.

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
