Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 14th day of May, 1924, that whereas the following described property, to-wit:

Lots No. 10, 11 and 12, of Fort Thatcher Place,

An addition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, is the property of the Kansas Alpha of Phi Delta Theta Alumni Corporation, and that said property is exempt from taxation under Section 79-302 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923.
