May 23<sup>rd</sup> 1924. To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas:

The Pi Epsilon Fraternity, a Kansas Corporation, contracted on July 19<sup>th</sup>, 1923 with Wilhelm and Jackson for the purchase of the following described tract of land located at 1420 Ohio Street, Lawrence, Kansas:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Ohio Street in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, 188 feet north of the South line of the South-west quarter of section 31, Township 12, Range 20, thence South 75 feet, thence East 90 feet, thence North 75 feet, thence West 90 feet to point of beginning, all in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.

The said Fraternity moved into these premises in Sep. 1923 and paid a monthly rental to said Wilhelm and Jackson until the title to the property was approved on or about Feb. 1<sup>st</sup>, 1924. No rental was paid after Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> 1924, and on Feb. 18<sup>th</sup>, 1924 the title actually passed from Wilhelm and Jackson to the Pi Epsilon Fraternity paying them in full for

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
