

The following Road Petition was filed with the County Clerk and presented to the Board of County Commissioners June 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Board considered said Petition signed by J. D. Wynn and others for a hard surfaced Road from Lawrence to Baldwin over the Pleasant Grove Route. They set Saturday June 28<sup>th</sup> at 2 P.M. as the time for hearing on said Road and instructed the County Clerk to give regular ten day notice.

Pleasant Grove Road Petition

Benefit District Petition for Road Improvement.  
To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners  
of Douglas County, Kansas.

We, the undersigned residents of said county and owning land in the Road Benefit District herein referred to, and hereby defined, and being more than fifty-one per cent (51%) of the resident landowners owning at least thirty-five per cent (35%) of the land within said district, or being more than thirty-five per cent (35%) of the resident landowners, owning at least fifty-one per cent (51%) of the land within said district, or being the owners of at least sixty per cent (60%) of the land within said district, respectfully petition your honorable body to permanently improve a certain road or roads in said county, named and known as the Lawrence-Baldwin Highway, connecting the old Santa Fe Trail with the Fort to Fort Road.

Said portion of said Road is located within said district. The terminal joints and other specially fixed locations thereof to be improved are as follows:

Description of the road for which improvement is asked:

Beginning at a joint in Lawrence, Kansas Center of Vermont Street on Twenty Third (23) Street, thence west on 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and County road to #6 School house, more definite to the north-west corner of section twelve (12) Township 13, Range 19 East; thence south on the County road to Pleasant Grove (not an incorporate town); thence due South on County road to Old Santa Fe Trail, more definite to the south-west corner of the south-east quarter of section 35, Township 14, Range 19, east. Thence east on the Santa Fe Trail to the west city limits of Baldwin, all in Douglas County, Kansas.

Benefit district number one (1) commencing at Center of Vermont Street on 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and ending at N.W. corner of sec. 12 Twp. 13, Range 19, East. a distance of about one and one quarter ( $1\frac{1}{4}$ ) miles.
