This meeting was called for the purpose of hearing complaints on the petition to hard surface that part of the Lawrence-Baldwin road lying between Vermont Street at 23rd in the City of Lawrence and number six school house west of that City limits. The regular ten day notice had been given and proof of publication furnished. A number of the petitioners were present but no objections were made. Those present were advised that the Board would take some action on the petition at the regular session of the Board in July.
