

Road Notice.

Road opening & paving
Frank Topping

Notice is hereby given that on the 14th day of June 1924 a road petition was filed in the Office of the County Clerk, signed by Frank Topping and 14 others; petitioning for the location of a public road, described as follows: - to wit:

Beginning at the North-east corner of the west one-half of the North-east quarter of Section 16, Twp. 13, range 22, running due south one-half mile and terminating at the south-east corner of the west-half of the North-east quarter of section 16, Twp. 13, range 22.

Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, appointed C. B. Hasford, Robt. Steele and G. E. Kretzinger as viewers with instructions to meet with the County Engineer, E. E. Trueblood, at the point of beginning of the above described road, Saturday July 26th 1924, at 2 P.M. and proceed to view said road and give all parties a hearing.

State Aid Road Resolution.

By the Board of County Commissioners, and
Notice to State Highway Commission.

Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas: That it desires to avail itself of the State aid road funds of said County, and does hereby designate that said funds shall be applied to the Fort to Fort (Project No. 7) Highway, described as follows, to wit:

State Aid Resolution
Project No. 7

Beginning at known as Project No. 1 - or Fort to Fort Highway in Douglas County, and extending thence along said highway a distance of 18.25 miles, more or less.

(4) Designated that said funds shall be applied to reimbursements for the permanent improvement of said highway constructed..... and which said highway has been properly maintained and is now in good condition.

Further resolved, That State aid be applied to said road at the rate of \$25,000.00, not to exceed \$10,000.00 per mile.

Further resolved; That the improvements herein provided for shall be constructed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Kansas of 1921.
