The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with C. B. Hooford, Robt Steele, G. E. Kretzinger and E. C. Bussing Present.

The following resolutions were acted upon by the Board.
 #1 Order and Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, Allowing the Petition for the Improvement of The Lawrence-Baldwin Road in Douglas County, Benefit District No. 1.

Now, upon this 16th day of July, 1924, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and all members of the said Board being present, the petition praying for the permanent improvement of a certain road, known as Lawrence-Baldwin Road, comes up for final consideration and action; and the Board having caused to be published a notice in the Lawrence Daily Journal World, a newspaper of general circulation on June 12th, 1924, being at least ten days prior to the date of the meeting of this Board for the consideration of the petition, and having carefully examined the said petition, and having carefully examined and caused to be examined the records of this county relating to the lands in said petition described, and after careful inquiry and full consideration, finds as follows:

- (1.) That the improvements as prayed for in said petition are of public utility; and
- (2.) That said petition is signed by twenty-nine individuals, who constitute more than 57% percent of the resident landowners owning more than 35 percent of the land within the district defined by said petition; and
- (3.) That said petition designated the road (or roads) to be improved sufficiently by name and by terminal points, and by other specially fixed locations; and
- (4.) That said petition definitely designates the lands within the proposed benefit district, also the type (or types) of permanent improvement and the width (or widths) of the roadway, also the number (or the maximum and minimum number) of annual assessments to be levied upon the lands in the benefit district in payment thereof, and that said petition is in all respects found to be in compliance with
