

Monday - August 4 - 1924

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The Board of County Commissioners met in the first meeting of the August session. Present, Hosford, Steele & Kutsinger and County Clerk.

Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed as per the allowance record.

The Board made the following reports on the roads petitioned for by Frank Topping and Frank Wulfkuehl.

The Frank Topping petition was granted, no damages were allowed for land or fences, since the road is already open and traveled and is now improved.

The Frank Wulfkuehl petition was granted and damages allowed as follows John Gress 1:22 acres land \$91.⁵⁰ O. A. Biddinger, 1:22 acres land \$91.⁵⁰

An agreement was reached, whereby Frank Wulfkuehl is to pay for the fence on each side of the road. The following road petition signed by F. M. Hartley and 18 others was presented to the Board and acted on by them as follows, Chris Schaake, H. D. Portier and Chas. Daugherty were appointed as viewers to meet at the point of beginning on said road at 10 A. M. Saturday Aug. 30 - 1924.

Petition follows -

Vacate & relocate as follows. Beginning at a point in the present County road 572 ft S. of the N. W. cor Sec 27-T. 14S-R. 20E. thence S. $12^{\circ}25'E$ - 1000 ft to P.C. 6° curve left. thence along said curve 587 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft to the P.T. of curve thence S. $47^{\circ}40'E$ - 352 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft to the top of the hill. Thence south about 490 ft. Thence W. about 670 ft. to a point in the present County road - = Vacate = present road from point of beginning noted above to the top of the hill, and from the top of the hill to the point where the above petitioned road joins the present road shall become a township road.

Wednesday August 6 - 1924 -

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Hosford, Kutsinger & County Clerk. Bills were allowed. Election returns were received and reports formed for the news papers.
