

Sec. 36. 466 feet to an iron pipe; thence north $40^{\circ}00'$ east 3833 feet to the center of an unnamed street on the west line of lots 15 and 16 in University Heights Part II; thence by said unnamed street east by street on south side of University Heights to the east line of south west 1/4 sec. 36-12-19.

For the reason that this petition is for the purpose of correcting an error in old description the Board passed a motion granting the above petition.

Wednesday Aug 13-1924

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Hosford Steele & Kretzinger & County Clerk. Much of the day was spent in making up the rates for the County Tax Levy. The request of the Douglas County Farm Bureau for an increase in appropriation from \$1916 to \$3610 was not granted, but on motion which carried the amount was set the same as 1923.

The monthly reports of Mrs. Kennedy, Com. of Poor. J. C. Syer, Supt. of Co. Home and E. R. Keith Co. Health officer were approved.

August 25-1924 -

The Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session for the purpose of making up of the Tax Levies for 1924. Present were commissioners C. B. Hosford, Robert Steele & E. Kretzinger and the County Clerk. A delegation of residents, mostly women, of the county came before the Board asking that the Board grant a rate of tax levy for the farm Bureau sufficient to raise \$3600. The Board on motion which carried unanimously reconsidered the action they had taken on Aug 13th refusing to grant a raise in the Farm Bureau Levy. By a unanimous vote the Board agreed on a levy of .074 mills for Farm Bureau Fund. That a Home Demonstration agent might be added to the staff of workers in the county.

Following is the levies as certified to the County from the different taxing bodies of the State, and County.
