

Tuesday September 2 - 1924

The Board of County Commissioners met in the first meeting of the September session. Present - Hosford, Stahl, Wetsinger and County Clerk.

Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed as per the allowance record.

The following petition signed by twenty three resident land owners and renters was presented to the board.

On the undersigned land owners and tax payers of Douglas County ask the commissioners of Douglas Co. to see that said described road, located on the east line of Willow Springs Township, line extending one mile south from Santa Fe Trail, and one mile north from Douglas Co. line,

on account of the lateness of the season, be worked at the earliest possible date, at the expense of Willow Springs Township.

The following action was taken by the board:

Resolved, that the County Clerk be instructed to notify the township trustee of Willow Springs township and the township trustee of Palmyra township to work the road lying between Willow Springs and Palmyra townships, commencing at the Santa Fe Trail and extending south to the Douglas county line and should Willow Springs fail to work their part of said road within one week, that the county forces will be instructed to work said road and charge the same to said Willow Springs township, and should Palmyra township fail to work their part of said road within ten days the county forces will be instructed to work said road and charge the same to Palmyra township.

The board met in adjourned regular session all members being present. Bills were allowed. Monthly reports of Emma J. Kennedy, commissioner of poor and H. C. Lizer, superintendent of the county home were presented and approved by the board. The appointment of F. O. Kingsbury as Deputy Sheriff was approved. The monthly report of Dr. C. R. Kille was approved. In the matter of the petition for grading the Baldwin hill (see page 131) the viewers reported favorably for opening a road 60 feet wide with this provision, That if it be found by further survey that the curve will not be too sharp at the top of the hill, that the route be resumed south from the top of the hill a distance of about 150 or 200 feet thence west to the present road at a point 200 or 300 feet north of the
