The Board of County Commissioners met in the first meeting of the September session. Present - Huford - Steele, Kretzinger and the County Clerk.

Claims against the County were presented, audited and allowed as per the allowance record.

The following petition was received and resolution passed.

To Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County Kansas.

Gentlemen: On behalf of the Kansas District of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, Ohio, and other States, a corporation, I beg of you to cancel the property: Lot 93 on Kentucky street, of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, from the tax list.

This property was formerly used as a carpenter shop by the late contractors Curtis and Preisach. This property has now come into our possession by purchase and will be used for church purposes only in the future.

As we understand, the Statutes of this State grant tax-exemption on all church property. In view of this we look forward to favorable action in this matter on your part, viz., to cancel this property from the tax list.

This request is respectfully submitted by the Kansas District of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, Ohio, and other States, per Mr. L. Herbolth, Local pastor of this church-body. (Dud was recorded on Sept. 17-1924)

Resolution

In the matter of the Application of the Kansas District of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, Ohio and other States.

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State of Kansas, in regular session this 6th day of October, 1924, that,

"Whereas, the following described property, to-wit:

"Lot 93 Kentucky Street, City of Lawrence."

is the property of the Kansas District of the Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, Ohio and other States, and that said property is exempt from taxation under section 79-201 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923,

Therefore - Be the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, recommend to the State Tax Commission that the above described property be exempt from taxation, and that the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas be instructed to mark the exemption of the above described property on the Assessment Rolls and Tax Rolls of Douglas County, Kansas."
