

The Board made a report of the final work on the West Campus Road Sept. 23rd 1924 together with the City Commission, the City Engineer and the County Engineer inspected the West Campus Road. The work of the contractors was accepted with the provision that the dirt shoulder be put in proper condition. Final bill not to be paid until all work is completed.

The month report of E. C. Sizer, superintendent of the County Home was approved by the board. The following quarterly reports were received and approved: D. F. Smith - Clerk of the District Court; L. H. Menger - Probate Judge; Isaac Willman - Register of Deeds; Will Johns - Sheriff; Arthur C. Huddleston - Treasurer; E. C. Bussing Co. Clerk.

Wednesday October 8th 1924

The Board met in adjourned regular session, all members were present. Bills were allowed as per the allowance record.

The County Engineer was appointed for a term to expire Jan. 1st 1927. The Monthly report of Mrs. Kennedy, Commissioner of Poor was received and approved.

The abstract and deed to lots 28-30 Corn. St. were received - the deed recorded and papers placed in file labeled, County Property. This being the property purchased for housing the County machinery. The County Commissioners owned some of the County roads, especially the road to Eudora.

The following Road Petition was filed with the County Clerk and presented to the Board of County Commissioners Oct. 9th 1924.

For the location of the road beginning at 160 rods west of the north east corner of section 29, Township 12, range 18 thence south 80 rods, and terminating at 80 rods from place of beginning.

Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners appointed H. D. Pontius, O. H. Banning and John Tobler as assessors with instructions to meet with the County Engineer Nov. 1st 1924 at ten A. M. and proceed to view said road and give all parties a hearing.

Wednesday - Oct. 15 - 1924

The Board met in adjourned regular session all members of the Board and the county clerk were present. Routine matters of business were discussed. The Board approved the annual report of A. E. Huddleston, County Treasurer. The Board ordered the County Clerk to issue an order canceling the tax on the Evans property - (Machinery shed) See Order No. 30 -
