The following Road Petition was filed with the County Clerk and presented to the Board of County Commissioners Oct. 8<sup>th</sup> 1924.

For the location of the road beginning at 160 rods west of the north east corner of section 29, township 12, range 18 thence south 80 rods, and terminating at 80 rods from place of beginning.

Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners appointed H. D. Pontius, O. H. Banning and John Tobler as commissioners with instructions to meet with the County Engineer Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 1924 at ten A. M. and proceed to view said road and give all parties a hearing.
