

Monday, December 1st 1924.

The Board of County Commissioners met in the first meeting of the December session. Present Commissioners Stafford, Steele & Kretzinger and the County Clerk. Claims against the county were presented and allowed at per the allowance record. The Board pro rated the Primary and General Election expenses for 1924 as follows and instructed the County Clerk to charge the same to the City of Lawrence and the several townships as pro rated -

The County Engineer, E. E. Trumblood, presented a bill against Willow Springs township for grading two miles of road south of the Old H. F. trail on the line between Palmyra & Willow Springs twp. as follows -

To Tractor driver 108 hrs. @ 40¢ = 43.20. Grader operator 108 hrs @ 40¢ = 43.20 Gasoline for 12 days @ 40¢ gal per day. 13¢ = 64.40. Motor Oil. 48 gals @ 58¢ = 27.84 Transmission Grease @ 1¢ = 12.00 Depreciation on tractor & grader @ 5¢ for 12 days 60¢ = Total 258.64

The Board instructed the County Clerk to charge the amount to the account of Willow Springs township.
