The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present Wadford Steele and Kutsinger and the County Clerk.

The following resolution was passed concerning the widening of Massachusetts Street along the west side of the Court House:

Resolution - Whereas the street on the west of the Court house grounds is narrower than the remaining portion of Massachusetts Street to the North and whereas the property owners on the west side of said street have signed the petition to widen Massachusetts street and whereas there is inadequate parking space for persons having business at the Court House. Now, therefore it is the sense of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County that Massachusetts should be widened for the safety and convenience of the public.

In the matter of the James Murphy road recorded on page 145 of the Journal. The report of the viewers was approved and the road granted as provided in section 68-117 & 68-124 of the Revised Statutes of 1923. Murphy to pay to the County Clerk all damages and expenses as provided by Statute by opening the road including expenses of viewers. The Board order the County Clerk to issue orders to the County Treasurer as follows: Cancel the tax against Mrs H^m Lines on \$1575. Valuation. Tax \$49.37 on account of erroneous assessment. also cancel tax against Mrs Susan Mason, 20th Tax 78¢ no exemption was allowed.
