In the matter of increasing the width of the Paving of Massachusetts street between Eleventh Street on the North and Park Drive on the South.

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, held at the Court House on this day, the following Resolution was adopted, to wit:

Whereas, The paved portion of Massachusetts street between Eleventh Street on the North and Park Drive on the South is too narrow to accommodate the traffic thereon, and

Whereas, it is desired that the paving on said street between the above named limits should be widened and extended.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That it is the sense of this Board that such improvement be made in the manner provided by law, and it joins the property owners in requesting the City to make such improvement.
