

The following communication was received and read.
Board of County Commissioners, Douglas Co., Kansas.
Gentlemen:

Having received the appointment as Postmaster in Lawrence, it becomes necessary that I resign from the Board of County Commissioners, and I herewith tender you my resignation and ask that the same be accepted and effective at once.

In presenting this resignation I cannot help but comment on the unselfish loyalty which the remaining members of the Board have shown at all times.

During my nearly three years of service I have at no time seen any question decided because the thing at issue happened to be in one district or the other. The spirit at all times has been service to Douglas County as a whole. Whatever success the Board has achieved in the last two or three years can be largely credited to the wholehearted co-operation of all the County Officials and especially those who work most closely with the County Commissioners.

I had very little notion when accepting this appointment of the enormous amount of work that had to be done on schedule time by our County Clerk's Office. The changing statutes have thrown additional burdens on all of our County Officials, but it is to the credit of Douglas County and its Officials that with the additional amount of work required by statute, very little additional expense has been added by our County Officials, they have merely done the extra work without incurring extra expense.

My experience with the Public in the adjustment of taxes and other matters makes me proud of the People of our County. In almost every complaint that has come before the Board there was some just cause. The spirit in which these things were brought and the spirit in which the Public accepted the decision of the Board makes me glad that I am a citizen of Douglas County. I am convinced that the Public is primarily interested in the honest expenditure of their money for essential improvements and they are entitled to just that thing.
