

Saturday February 7-1925

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Commissioners Kretzinger, Kennedy and Burton and County Clerk Bussing.

The monthly reports of S. C. Sizer, Supt. County Home, Mrs. Emma J. Kennedy, Com. of Poor, and E. P. Keith Health Officer.

The Board instructed the County Clerk order the County Treasurer to transfer \$3068.34 from the State Aid Road Fund to the West Campus Road fund. This being the county's share of the cost of the West Campus Road. See order #42 = also to cancel tax on P.P. of Edward L. Hutchins, Adm. Baldwin Kane. order #43

The following road petition was presented to the Board at the December session and was held over on account of the changing of the personnel of the county Board. Petition follows -
Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of section 35, in Township Eleven, (11), South of Range, Section (17) East, thence Northeasterly about one-fourth (1/4) mile, thence north of east thirty (30) rods, thence north about twenty-five (25) rods to a point of intersection with the Fourth Street road one hundred twenty (120) rods east of the northwest corner of above mentioned tract of land. A. Morton White was the last signer and W. O. McClanahan signed as principal petitioner.

McClanahan Road Petition

This road is being asked for rather than a road on the county line between Douglas and Shawnee counties where the hills are almost impassable. The Board by arrangement met the Shawnee County Commissioners on the road location. Friday February 6th to talk of the plan of paying for the road jointly. The Shawnee Board agreed to pay half the cost except that part of cost calling for the payment of land that might be used in re-locating the road. The Board appointed themselves, S. E. Kretzinger, V. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton as viewers to view the road and give all parties a hearing to meet at the point of beginning March 4th at 10 A.M.

The afternoon was spent in a joint meeting with the township Boards talking over roads and other matters of interest in the county.
