

Monday March 2-1925-

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The Board of County Commissioners met in the first meeting of the March session. Present were Chairman E. E. Kutsinger, H. J. Kennedy, and D. L. Burton and County Clerk, E. C. Bussing. Claims against the county were presented and allowed as per the allowance record. The Board held a conference with the county engineer on road matters in the county.

Wednesday, March 4-1925

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Kutsinger, Kennedy and Burton and County Clerk Bussing. The Board proceeded to the County line where together with the Board of County Commissioners of Shawnee county they view the road petition for by H. O. McClanahan and steps in the north-west corner section of the county which road takes the place of a road on the county line. (see page 159) The road was approved and Shawnee commissioners agreed to pay one half the cost not including land damages and not to exceed \$425.00.

The Board returned to their office and continued allowing bills as per the allowance record. The Board issued an order on the road mentioned above setting forth that in relocating this road that all roads or parts of roads being abandoned by said relocation, should be and are hereby vacated.

Saturday March 7-1924

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Kutsinger, Kennedy and Burton and County Clerk.
