The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present Kretzinger, Kennedy and Burton and County Clerk Bulesing. Harold N. Running of Topeka Kansas, came before the Board with a claim for damages because of an accident between his Hudson car and a small grader being towed behind a Ford roadster truck. The bill for repairs on the car ^{was} \$47.50; as the county had suffered damage on the grader the Board decided to allow \$31.25 to Mr. Running in the way of a compromise.
