The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. Present Chairman Kutsinger, Commissioners Kennedy & Burton and County clerk Bussing. Claims against the county were presented and allowed as per the allowance record.

A road petition signed by Charles Becke and 14 others was filed in the office of the county clerk asking for the widening and improving of certain roads described as follows: - Beginning at a point 162 feet north and 10 ft. east of the quarter corner between sections 27 & 28 - T. 14S - R. 20E. Thence South on proposed center line of road parallel to and 10 ft. East of section line, 5465.8 ft. to angle 10 ft. E. of quarter corner between sections 33 & 34 - T. 14S - R. 20E. and up to the above angle point shall be a 60 foot right of way for about one mile. Thence South 0-51', East - 1721.9 feet to angle pt. in center of present 40 foot road. Thence South 0-23', East - 934.3 feet along center line of present
