North 50 feet of Lot 2, in Block 8, of the Quad edition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas,

Is the property of the Kansas Chapter of Delta Upsilon Alumnae and that said property is entitled to exemption under section 29-203 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas for 1923.

Therefore, Be the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, recommended to the State Tax Commission that the County Clerk of Douglas County be instructed to mark the same exempt on the assessment rolls and tax rolls of Douglas Co, Kas.
