

Therefore, it is now by the Public Service Commission on this 24th day of April, 1925,

Ordered, That the action of the said Board be and the same is approved and authority is given to show on the Assessment and Tax Rolls of said County that the aforementioned property is exempt from taxation until such time as the ownership or use brings it within the law for taxation purposes.

It is further,

Ordered, and directed that the County Clerk and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County issue to the applicant a refunding warrant in the sum of \$81.57 the same being the amount of the first half tax for 1924 which was paid under protest and to abate and cancel the remaining one half tax in the sum of \$81.57 which latter amount has not yet been paid and to charge said amounts back to the funds for which they were originally levied.
