Said bonds shall be dated July 1st, 1925, which is hereby declared to be the date of the execution and the issuance of the same; shall be in the following denominations: two (2) bonds for the amount of \$500.00, each, and eight (8) bonds for the sum of \$300.00, each. One of said bonds to become due each year for a period of 10 years hereafter beginning July 1st, 1926; shall bear interest at the rate of $4\frac{3}{4}$ per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually, on the first days of January and July of each year, for which coupons shall be attached, bearing the signatures of the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerk of Douglas County.

Said bonds and interest coupons shall be payable at the Office of the State Treasurer in Topeka, Kansas, (being the fiscal agency of the State of Kansas), and the full faith credit and all of the resources of Douglas County, Kansas are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of said bonds and interest coupons as the same severally mature, said bonds shall be numbered, in denomination, amount due, and become due and payable as follows:
