Section 4. Said bonds shall be registered by the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, and with the Auditor of the State of Kansas in the manner provided by law. When so executed and registered, said bonds shall be delivered to the ———, the purchasers thereof, and upon payment thereof, full and final receipt shall be given. The proceeds from the sale of the same shall be deposited in the fund for payment of said improvements, and the Board of County Commissioners shall annually levy upon all taxable property in Douglas County liable therefore, a tax sufficient to produce a fund to pay off the bonds and interest coupons described herein as they severally mature; and said board hereby irrevocably bind itself and Douglas County, Kansas, during the life of said bonds to levy and collect such tax and retire said bonds and coupons at maturity. Section 6. — This resolution shall be in force and take effect from and after this 4th day of May 1925.
