Board met in adjourned regular session present S. E. Kretzinger, chairman and K. J. Kennedy and county clerk Bursing. The following application for exemption was presented and resolution passed.

To the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County State of Kansas; S.S.: We represent that we, the Upsilon chapter of the Phi Delta Chi fraternity are a non-profit corporation chartered under the state of Kansas. That the said corporation holds a fee simple title to the following described property, to wit: Lot four (4) Block three (3) Broad Heights, an addition to the City of Lawrence, of Douglas County, Kansas. That the said property is less than one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of one (1) acre in extent. That the aforesaid corporation entered into possession of the said property on or about September 15, 1924. That the aforesaid property is occupied solely as a chapter house operated upon non-profit basis for members. And that its members are all students of the University of Kansas, an educational institution. Therefore we humbly pray the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County of the State of Kansas that the aforesaid property be exempted from taxation until such time as its use and occupancy shall be changed.
