The following Road Petition was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, signed by W. M. Clark and others praying for the relocation of certain county road for the purpose of widening and straightening the same, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of section 16-T-14 S. R 20 E. Thence south on the section line to the northeast corner of section 21-T. 14 S. - R 20 E. - Thence continuing south on the section line to the northeast corner of section 28-T. 14 S. R 20 E. - Thence south between sections 27 and 28 about 450 feet, to the point of beginning of the new road over the Baldwin Hill. We ask that the above described road be opened sixty feet wide, and thereby utilizing all of the present forty foot right of way, except a strip of land ten feet wide along the west side of the present right of way, from the north east corner of section 21-T. 14 S - R 20 E - Thence south one-half mile to the quarter corner on the East line of said section 21, which we ask to be vacated for public use.
