In the matter of the exemption from taxation of certain real estate now owned by the City of Lawrence.

Application.

To the Board of County Commissioners: Gentlemen: The City of Lawrence has purchased the following described property for cemetery purposes, and we ask your honorable body to remove same from the tax rolls, property described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 12, Range 20; thence north 409 feet to south line of cemetery road; thence westerly along said road 207 feet to a stake; thence south 448 feet; thence east 203 3/4 to place of beginning. Resolution.

Whereas the City of Lawrence has purchased certain real estate, for cemetery purposes, described as follows:
