The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. met in adjourned regular session. Present Chairman D. E. Kretsinger, V. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton and County Clerk E. C. Bussing. The Board met in adjourned regular session Present D. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, V. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton and E. C. Bussing County Clerk. At 10.4. M. The hour set for opening bids on the \$3400⁰⁰ issue West Campus Road Improvement Bonds the bids were called for. Only the Lawrence Keth Bank submitted a bid. By unanimous vote the bid of said bank was accepted, and County Clerk instructed to sell the bonds to said bank at the price offered \$3435.95.

The Board signed the following orders resolutions and applications, for the improvement of the following named and numbered roads, to include Federal Aid.

- (1) The Lawrence-Kansas City Road (in Douglas Co) order and resolution of the Board of County Comm. of Douglas County, Kansas for the improvement of the Lawrence-K.C. (in Douglas county) road by the use of the General Road and Bridge Funds. Now on this 13th day of May 1925 at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the Board of County Comm. of Douglas County, and all members of said Board being present, the matter of the improvement of the Lawrence-Kansas City road (in Douglas County) comes up for final consideration and action by said Board, and having carefully considered said proposed improvement, and having made an examination of the present condition
