The total bridge fee to be paid when the plans and estimates are approved by the State Highway Engineer. It is to be understood that the section corners are to be located by the County Engineer, without charge to the Party of the Second Part.

It is understood that the Party of the First Part reserves the right to have the County Engineer prepare the bridge plans for the above described roads in which case the Party of the Second Part shall receive no compensation for bridge plans.
