The City of Eudora, Kansas being a city of the third class, hereby makes application for assistance in the construction of the improvement of the Lawrence-Kansas City Road through said city according to section 2, Chapter 218, Laws of 1921.

The road to be constructed as a part of the contract for the improvement of said Lawrence-Kansas City Road, and to be constructed through said city as follows.
