Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per the allowance record.

Wednesday September 9-1925-

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present Chairman G.E. Kertsinger, H.J. Kennedy, D.L. Burton and County Clerk E.C. Bussing. The Board went to Eudora to meet with the Commissioners of Leavenworth County to make plans for repairing the bridge across the Kansas river. The commissioners and engineers from both counties returned to the Douglas court house for conference. The following motion by Mr. Kennedy carried unanimously. Motion - That the engineers of the two counties prepare and submit estimate of cost of repairing the 900 foot span with the view of using old material for the approaches; and further that engineers shall find out if work can be done by force account or if must be contracted.

Claims against the county were presented and allowed as per the allowance record.

The Board ordered the taxes and all charges cancelled for the year 1924 on lots 72-74-76 on Elm street City of Baldwin for the reason same were ordered cancelled by the Public Service Com (see order No. .)

The monthly reports of the Emma J. Kennedy, Com. of Poor, S.C. Lizer, Supt. of County Home, and E.W. Keith health officer were approved by the Board.
